



Sample Holiday Itinerary

Night 1

Arrive at Rio de Janeiro International Airport with meet & greet and transfer to your hotel. Free time as dependent upon your time of arrival.

Day 2/ Night 2

Buffet breakfast in your hotel then pick up for a guided tour to Christ the Redeemer and Sugar Loaf Mountain. With their views over the City, you will start getting your 'bearings'. Lunch at Zozô with a familiarisation Rio briefing.

Day 3/ Night 3

Buffet breakfast in your hotel followed by day at leisure. We suggest on Copacabana or Ipanema beach (use your sun block liberally as necessary!). Then pick up from your hotel at around 8.00pm and transfer to the Rio Scenarium in Lapa to dance the night away. And in the early hours of the morning, our Back|Street tour will take you to an amateur – but not less skilful or competitive – local football match.

Day 4/ Night 4

You might want to lie in and skip the hotel buffet breakfast! Then if not the beach, we suggest a stroll around Downtown Centro dropping in the Columbian Coffee House for a snack. Then take the tram up to Santa Teresa for a walkabout. If you're still there as the sun begins to go down head for the Maze Inn to enjoy a beautiful sunset and some cool jazz.

Day 5/ Night 5

What you've been patiently waiting for! To join the crowds go crazy for a full-on, Campeonato Brasileiro da Série A football match. We'll pick you up from your hotel and escort to the ground and your seats. Subject to the fixture list, we'll take you to see Flamengo, and if they win, can drop you off at Ataulfo de Paiva where their fans always gather after matches when they win or at Shenangan's Irish Pub & Sports Bar rather than back to your hotel.

Day 6/Night 6

Following your buffet breakfast, perhaps a few hours on the beach and a kickabout on the sand and a lunch snack at one of the kiosks before being picked up in the early afternoon for our guided Back|Street football tour into the neighbourhood returning mid evening so you can head out for dinner. We recommend a meat rodizo (all you can eat) Brazilian barbecue at the Carretao or Porcao.

Day 7/Night 7

Your last full day in Rio so we best leave what you do up to you! You may want to retrace your steps, see more sites (a helicopter ride is a great way!) or catch up with new friends. If you'd like us to arrange something special, just ask.

Day 8

Buffet breakfast in your hotel and checkout. Depending on your flight time, a good idea is to pack your swimming costume in hand luggage and have one last swim in the Atlantic because you can grab a towel and have a shower 'below' one of the new kiosks on Copacabana beach.
